Available for Ordination

This page is to inform the candidates for Ministerial Ordination under the Headship of It Ain't Over Ministries of the "Title" that will be awarded to you when you have satisfactorily completed all of the required steps of our Ministerial Ordination Program.

After having spent many years in Ministry, we fully understand the many different "Roles", "Offices", "Titles", and "Positions" outlined and used in Scripture pertaining to a person's giftings and calling. Therefore, due to the seriousness of being the overseeing Governing body of a person whom we issue a Ministerial Ordination to, it needs to be made known that we will only issue you a "Title" of "Minister" or "Ministress", and this dependent upon your gender at birth. Meaning, if you are a "Male" and we extend "Ordination" to you, you, as a male, will be issued the Ministerial Title of "Minister". And too, likewise, if you are a "Female" and we extend "Ordination" to you, you, as a female, will be issued the Ministerial Title of "Ministress".

We have prayerfully made this decision due to the rampant sin nature of the human individual and the ability this has to allow any other Ecclesiastical Title of Ordination to go to the person's head, inflating it with pride and leading to the person's downfall and demise; and therefore, misrepresenting It Ain't Over Ministries and bringing a bad reputation to our impeccable character and the overall integrity of our Ministry.

These simple "Ministerial Titles" of, "Minister" & "Ministress", will help to keep the person receiving Ordination humble and focused on God and the furtherance of His Kingdom, rather than giving them the ability to be led astray by the enemy of our souls, and building his kingdom or the person's own kingdom.



If God has called & gifted you with the ability, skill, and talents of any other Ecclesiastical Title as used properly in Scripture, you wear that title at your own risk and detriment if you are found not operating & living it out daily. Therefore, if you are called by God to be a “Pastor”, then be a “Pastor”; if an “Evangelist” then be an “Evangelist”; if a “Prophetess” then be a “Prophetess”, and so on, and do all of these works and fulfill the specific office to which God has called you without all of the fanfare, accoutrements, parading, and advertising yourself as such.

Always remember, that no one in Scripture went around calling themselves by these different “Titles” to bring recognition upon themselves. It is an unruly pridefulness, and very narcissistic to run around parading a “Title” to the world, and is more so than not, a turn-off to your fellow Brothers and Sisters in the Faith, and the world, for you to do such a thing.
